There is no place like home."

















Accordian Fold with title on top.

Cut out individually and stack with image on top. Staple on side or top. The China Shepherdess








Cut out individually. Stack and attach with staple on top or side.

Fold in Half with writing on top





Card fold. Cut around train for more interest.






Cut out on solid lines. Stack pages with image on top. Staple together or attach with brad




Winter Days Cut out individually Strange Awakening and stack with image on top. Staple on side or top. An Old Friend Matchbook fold


